A. "The Word of God" as \_\_\_\_\_

- John 1:1, 1:14; Rev 19:13.

B. "The Word of God" as \_\_\_\_\_

1. God's \_\_\_\_\_ (Gen 1:3, Ps 33:6, Heb 1:3)
2. God's Words \_\_\_\_\_ (Ex 20:1-3, Matt 3:17)
3. God's Words as \_\_\_\_\_ (Deut 18:18-20, Jer 1:9).  
- Frequently in Scripture God raises up prophets through whom he speaks.
4. God's Words in \_\_\_\_\_ (Ex 31:18, Deut 31:9, Josh 24:26,  
Isa 30:8, Jer 30:2, 1 Cor 14:37)

There are benefits of writing down God's words ...

- a. More accurate preservation of God's words for subsequent generations.
- b. Opportunity for repeated inspection permits careful study and discussion.
- c. Accessible to many more people.

**The Focus of Our Study is the \_\_\_\_\_!**

1. It is the form of God's Word that is available for study, for public inspection, for repeated examination, and as a basis for mutual discussion.
2. Other forms of the Word of God are not suitable as the primary basis for the study of theology.
